Position Overview

As an outreach volunteer for our Habitat ReStores, you will be working along with staff and other volunteers to inform community members about Habitat ReStores. Letting the public know about shopping, donating and volunteer opportunities at our ReStores and our Deconstruction Service.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Be an experienced Habitat volunteer or pre-read training material or attend a training session provided before the event
- Talk to the public at one or more farmers markets, festivals, community fairs and other public events
- Help set up before the event and take down the Habitat display at the end
- Share information about how people can shop, donate or volunteer at the ReStores

Qualifications /Skills/Physical Requirements

- Good verbal communications skills in English (other languages an asset)
- Friendly, energetic, social individuals that are able to speak comfortably to strangers about Habitat
- Own transportation to and from the event
- Able to be on your feet most of the event
