Duties

- Assist the warehouse coordinator unloading, sorting and loading shipments
- Keep the warehouse organized
- Use pump truck and dollies to move materials
- Follow all Habitat GTA health and safety policies

- Ability to lift 40 to 50 lbs
- Steel toe boots are mandatory. (We may be able to loan you a pair if you don't have your own) All other safety equipment and tools provided.
